Having been convicted by a District Court Martial, held at A.29 C.I.T.C., Camp Ipperwash, Ontario on the 2nd day of February, for the offence of:

First Charge

When on Active Service, Absenting Yourself Without Leave in that you at A.29 C.I.T.C. Camp Ipperwash, Ontario, at 2359 hours 28th December 1943 absented himself until he surrendered himself to the civil authorities at 2330 hours on the 27th day of January, 1943 at Leamington, Ontario, dressed in civilian clothes. A.A. 12(1)a Assessed Cost of Transportation - \$10.50

Second Charge

Conduct to the prejudice of Good Order and Military Discipline in that he at Leamington, Ontario, on the 28th day of January 1943, was improperly dressed, wearing civilian clothes. A.A. 40

Third Charge

Losing by neglect his equipment, Clothing and Regimental Necessaries in that he at A.29 C.I.T.C., Camp Ipperwash, Ontario, on the 2nd day of February 1943 was deficient of articles to the amount of \$7.72 A.A. 24 (2)

Was sentenced on 2 Mar 43 to undergo detention for a period of one hundred and twenty days, sentence commencing 2 Mar 43 and confirmed by the D.O.C., M.D. 1, London, Ontario, on 5 Mar 43, and to be put under stoppages of pay until he has made good the sum of \$10.50 in respect of cost of apprehension and return to his corps and until he has made good the value of clothing to the amount of \$7.72.

Total stoppages of pay \$18.22.

Promulgated and extracts taken at A.29 C.I.T.C., Camp Ipperwash, Ontario on the 10th day of March 1943.

Forfeits 34 days pay while held in close arrest.
