### CHECK THE TENSION

The garments in this book are worked to the exact tension given. Check your tension. Before beginning your garment take the wool and needles specified. Cast on 20 stitches. Work 20 rows stocking stitch and compare with the tension given in the instructions. All given tension is measured over stocking stitch. If your tension is too loose try a size smaller needle. If your tension is too tight try a size larger needle. Be sure to work to the exact tension given if you want your garments to work to correct size.

#### TO MAKE TASSELS

Cut a piece of cardboard 1½ inches wide and 3 inches long. Wind a piece of wool 20 times round and round width. Break the wool, leaving an end about 6 inches long and thread end through a wool needle. Slip needle through all the loops on the cardboard and tie the wool tightly at one edge. Slip off the cardboard and wind the wool several times around the loops ½-inch from fold. Draw the needle through the top and sew the tassel to the end of the tie. Cut through the other fold and even off the ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

KNITTING: K=knit plain. P=purl. p.s.s.o. = pass slip stitch over. Sl. = Slip. Wl. fwd. = wool forward. tog. = together. ins. = inches. dec. = decrease. inc. = increase. t.b.I. = through back of loops.

The star symbol—\*This indicates that the directions immediately following are to be repeated. When directions call for repeating a given number of times, it is understood this is in addition to the original. Thus, repeat 3 times means 4 times altogether.

To knit "even"—The row or work is knitted without increasing or decreasing.

Important:—When the instructions read — Cast off 2 sts. K2. (or similar sts.) the stitch on the right hand needle after casting off, is counted as 1 stitch.

## BABY'S GARMENTS 1st size to 1 yr.

BABY'S BONNET (to match coat) 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 1 oz. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles.

3 months: 1 oz. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles.

For Tension and Stitch pattern see Baby's
Coat, page 8.

TO MAKE A BONNET TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 1 oz. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) cast on 76 sts. loosely. Work 11 rows plain knitting (Garter st.). Continue even in pattern until work measures approx. 3 ins. from beginning ending with 4th pattern row. Next row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Work 20 rows ribbing (K1. P1). Next row: Knit, inc. across row to 81 sts. on needle. Proceed:—

1st row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 14 times.

To shape back of bonnet: \*K7. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 2nd and alternate rows: Knit. 3rd row: \*K6. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 5th row: \*K5. K2 tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 7th row: \*K4. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. Continue decreasing in this manner, every alternate row to 18 sts. on needle. Break wool and run end through remaining sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

To make up: Sew up seam for 3 ins. Turn brim back and sew along each side. Crochet two cords and stitch to each side of bonnet. Make two small tassels and attach one to each end of cord. See page 2.

If preferred ribbon may be used, making a small rosette for each side of bonnet.

BABY'S ROUND YOKE COAT for 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 2 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 3 months: 2 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. One Stitch Holder or spare needle. One medium Crochet Hook.

Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles.  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension-see page 2.

TO MAKE A COAT TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 3 ozs. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

RIGHT FRONT: With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) cast on 60 sts. 1st row: Knit across the 60 sts. 2nd row: As 1st row. 3rd row: K48. Turn. (The remaining 12 sts. form the Yoke and are worked only on 1st and 2nd rows). 4th row: K48. Repeat these 4 rows until there are 38 ridges at lower edge and 19 ridges at Yoke edge. \*\*Next row: Knit to Yoke edge.

To make sleeve: K22. Slip remaining 38 sts. onto st. holder or spare needle. Cast on 30 sts. for sleeve. (52 sts. on needle). 1st row: K40. Turn. 2nd row: K32. Turn. (Cuff edge). 3rd row: K44. 4th row: Knit across all 52 sts. Repeat these 4 rows until there are 19 ridges at Cuff edge. Next row: Cast off 30 sts. for sleeve.\*\* K10. Turn.

To make Back: K10. Pick up and knit the 38 sts. from st. holder. (60 sts. on needle). Tie coloured thread to mark beginning of Back. Continue knitting as for Front until there are 48 ridges from coloured thread, at lower edge.

To make 2nd sleeve: Work from \*\* to \*\* once.

LEFT FRONT: K10. Turn. K10. Pick up and knit the 38 sts. from st. holder. (60 sts. on needle). Tie coloured thread to mark beginning of Front. Continue knitting as for Right Front until there are 38 ridges from coloured thread, at lower edge. Cast off.

NECK: Pick up and knit 1 st. in each ridge around yoke, (approx. 108 sts). 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: \*K4.K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 4th row: Knit. 5th row: (eyelets) \*K1. Wl. fwd. K2tog. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts. K2. 6th row: Knit. 7th row: \*K2. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 8th row: Knit. Cast off.

To make up: Sew up sleeve seams. Crochet Picot edge around coat and cuffs. Picot edge: Join wool in 1st st. \*1 s.c. in next st. Ch. 3. 1 s.c. in same st. Miss 1 st. Repeat from \* around coat. Fasten off. Crochet a cord and thread through eyelets at neck. Make small tassels and sew to each end. See page 2.

BABY'S MITTS without thumbs. 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 1 oz. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 3 months: 1 oz. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. Tension: 8 sts. =1 inch with No. 10 needles.  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. =1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension—see page 2.

TO MAKE MITTS TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 1 oz. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) cast on 34 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row 21 times. Next row: (eyelets) \*K2. Wl. fwd. K2tog. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts. K2. Next row: K1. Inc. 1 st. in next st. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc. 1 st. in next st. K1. Work 29 rows plain knitting. (Garter st).

To shape top: K2. \*K2tog. K4. Repeat from \* to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 2nd row: \*K4. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 3rd and alternate rows: Knit. 4th row: \*K3. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 6th row: \*K2. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 8th row: \*K1. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. Break wool and run end through remaining sts. Fasten off securely. Make a crocheted chain and thread through holes at wrist, finishing off with small tassel at each end. See page 2.

### BABY'S COAT for 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 2 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 3 months: 2 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. One stitch holder or spare needle.

Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles.  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

### Check your tension-see page 2.

TO MAKE COAT TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 4 ozs. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions, but where measurements are given add ½ inch to 3 mos. size for 6 mos. and 1 inch for 1 year.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

PATTERN: 1st row: K4. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 4 sts. K4. 2nd row: As 1st row. 3rd row: K4. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to last 4 sts. K4. 4th row: As 3rd row.

The coat is worked in one piece to the armholes.

With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) cast on 136 sts. Work 11 rows plain knitting (Garter st.). Continue even in pattern until work measures 6½ ins. from beginning, ending with 4th pattern row (3 mos.—7 ins.). Next row: (1st pattern row). K4. (K2. P2.) 8 times. Turn. Put remaining sts. on st. holder. Proceed with Right Front:—

To make armhole: (worked without shaping). Working on the 36 sts. keeping 4 sts. at Front edge in Garter st. for Border, work 2nd pattern row. Keeping continuity of pattern continue even until work measures approx.  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from where sts. were divided (3 mos.—approx. 3 ins.) ending with 4th pattern row.

To shape neck: K16. (K2. P2.) 5 times. 2nd row: (K2. P2) 5 times. K16. 3rd row: K16. (P2. K2) 5 times. 4th row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K16. 5th row: Cast off 12 sts. K4. (K2. P2) 5 times. 6th row: (K2. P2) 5 times. K4. 7th row: K4. (P2. K2) 5 times. 8th row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K4. Cast off.

BACK: Join wool and pick up 64 sts. from st. holder, where division of sts. was made. Beginning with 1st pattern row continue even in pattern until work measures same as Front, to where sts. were cast off for neck, ending with 4th pattern row. Proceed:—1st row: (K2. P2) 4 times. K32. (K2. P2) 4 times. 2nd row: As 1st row. 3rd row: (P2. K2) 4 times. K32. (P2. K2) 4 times. 4th row: As 3rd row. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT: Join wool and pick up remaining 36 sts. from st. holder. Beginning with 1st pattern row, keeping 4 sts. at Front edge in Garter st. for Border continue even until work measures approx. 2½ ins. from where sts. were divided (3 mos.—3 ins.) ending with 4th pattern row.

To shape neck: (K2. P2) 5 times. K16. 2nd row: K16. (K2. P2) 5 times. 3rd row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K16. 4th row: Cast off 12 sts. K4. (P2. K2) 5 times. 5th row: (K2. P2) 5 times. K4. 6th row: K4. (K2. P2) 5 times. 7th row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K4. 8th row: K4. (P2. K2) 5 times. Cast off.

SLEEVES: Cast on 48 sts. Work 11 rows plain knitting (Garter st.). Continue even in pattern as given for Baby's Cap, see page 11 until work measures approx. 5 ins. from beginning (3 mos.—5½ ins.) ending with 4th pattern row. Cast off.

To make up: Press all pieces carefully being careful not to flatten pattern. Sew all seams. Crochet two cords and attach to each front at neck. Make small tassel and sew to each end. See page 2.

### KNITTED SHAWL.

MATERIALS: Approx. 10 ozs. MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGERING.

Two No. 5 Knitting Needles.

Cast on 3 sts. 1st row: Inc. 1 st. in 1st st. Knit to end of row. Repeat this row until work measures 36 ins. at side edge. Next row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. Repeat last row to 3 sts. on needle. K3tog. Fasten off.

### BABY'S PANTIES for 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 2 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 3 months: 2 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. Tension: 8 sts. =1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7½ sts. =1 inch with No. 9 needles.

### Check your tension—see page 2.

TO MAKE PANTIES TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 3 ozs. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions, but where measurements are given add ½ in. to 3 mos. size for 6 mos. and 1 inch for 1 year.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) beginning at top cast on 72 sts. 1st row: \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row twice. 4th row: (eyelets) \*K2. w.r.n. P2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row 8 times. Continue even in plain knitting (Garter st.) until work measures 6½ ins. from beginning. Proceed:—

To make leg: 1st row: K18. Turn. 2nd row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 3rd row: K14. K2tog. K1. 4th row: As 2nd row. Continue decreasing every row, in this manner, until 1 st. remains. Fasten off. Beginning again on remaining sts. knit to end of row. Proceed:—

1st row: K15. K2tog. K1. Turn. 2nd row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 3rd row: K13. K2tog. K1. 4th row: As 2nd row. Continue decreasing every row, in this manner, to 1 st. Fasten off.

Continuing on remaining 36 sts. knit 11 rows even. Inc. 1 st. each end of needle next and every alternate row to 72 sts. on needle. Knit 6½ ins. even. Work ribbing and eyelets to correspond to Front.

To make up: Sew all seams. With double wool crochet a cord. Thread through eyelets at waist. Make and sew a small tassel to each end. See page 2.

BABY'S CAP (to match coat, page 8) 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 1 oz. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 3 months: 1 oz. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles.

Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles.  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

### Check your tension—see page 2.

TO MAKE A CAP TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 1 oz. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) cast on 84 sts. loosely. Work 11 rows plain knitting (Garter st.). Proceed:—

1st row: \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 4 sts. K2. P1. K1. 2nd row: As 1st row. 3rd row: K1. P1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts. K2. 4th row: As 3rd row. Repeat these 4 rows until work measures approx. 2½ ins. from beginning ending with 4th row. Next row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Work 16 rows ribbing (K1. P1). Next row: Knit, inc. across row to 90 sts. on needle. Proceed:—

1st row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 16 times.

To shape top of cap: \*K8. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 2nd and alternate rows: Knit. 3rd row: \*K7. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 5th row: \*K6. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. 7th row: \*K5. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row. Continue decreasing in this manner, every alternate row to 18 sts. on needle. Break wool and run end through remaining sts. Draw up and fasten securely. Sew up back seam.

### BABY BOY'S PULLOVER. 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 2 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 3 months: 2 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. 3 buttons.

Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles.  $7\frac{1}{2}$  ins. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

### Check your tension-see page 2.

TO MAKE A PULLOVER TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 4 ozs. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions, but where measurements are given add ½ inch to 3 mos. size for 6 mos. and 1 inch for 1 year.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

PATTERN: 1st row: \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to end of row. 2nd row: As 1st row. 3rd row: \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to end of row. 4th row: As 3rd row.

BACK: With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) cast on 68 sts. Work 11 rows plain knitting (Garter st.). Continue even in pattern until work measures approx. 9 ins. from beginning (3 mos.—9½ ins.) ending with 4th pattern row. Proceed:—

1st row: (K2. P2) 4 times. K34. P2. (K2. P2) 4 times. 2nd row: As 1st row. 3rd row: (P2. K2) 4 times. P2. K34. (P2. K2) 4 times. 4th row: As 3rd row. Cast off.

FRONT: Work as given for Back until work measures approx. 6 ins. (3 mos.—6½ ins.) from beginning, ending with 4th pattern row. Proceed:—

1st row: (K2. P2) 8 times. K4. Turn. Working on these 36 sts. for Left Front proceed:—2nd row: K4. (K2. P2) 8 times. 3rd row: (P2. K2) 8 times. K4. 4th row: K4. (P2. K2) 8 times. 5th row: (buttonhole) (K2. P2) 8 times. K1. Wl. fwd. K2 tog. K1. 6th row: K4. (K2. P2) 8 times. 7th row: (P2. K2) 8 times. K4. 8th row: K4. (P2. K2) 8 times. 9th row: (K2. P2) 8 times. K4. Repeat from 2nd to 9th row once, then 2nd to 4th row once.

To shape neck: 1st row: (K2. P2) 5 times. K16. 2nd row: K16. (K2. P2) 5 times. 3rd row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K13. Wl. fwd. K2tog. K1. 4th row: Cast off 12 sts. K4. (P2. K2) 5 times. 5th row: (K2. P2) 5 times. K4. (P2. K2) 5 times. (K2. P2) 5 times. 7th row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K4. 8th row: K4. (P2. K2) 5 times. Cast off. Cast on 4 sts. and working across remaining 32 sts. (K2. P2) 8 times. 2nd row: (K2. P2) 8 times. K4. 3rd row: K4. (P2. K2) 8 times. 4th row: (P2. K2) 8 times. Repeat from 2nd to 5th rows 3 times, 2nd to 4th rows once.

To shape neck: 1st row: K16. (K2. P2) 5 times. 2nd row: (K2. P2) 5 times. K16. 3rd row: K16. (P2. K2) 5 times. 4th row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K16. 5th row: Cast off 12 sts. K4. (K2. P2) 5 times. 6th row: (K2. P2) 5 times. K4. 7th row: K4. (P2. K2) 5 times. 8th row: (P2. K2) 5 times. K4. Cast off.

SLEEVES: Work exactly as given for Sleeves of Baby's Coat. See page 9.

To make up: Press all pieces carefully. Sew seams. Sew the 4 cast-on sts. in position on wrong side of work. Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

### BABY'S KNEE BOOTEES for 1st size and 3 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 1 oz. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 3 months: 1 oz. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. Tension: 8 sts. =1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7½ sts. =1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension-see page 2.

TO MAKE BOOTEES TO FIT SIZES 6 MOS. AND 1 YEAR. Use 2 ozs. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 10 Knitting Needles for 6 mos. and two No. 9 Knitting Needles for 1 year. Follow same instructions, but where measurements are given add ½ inch to 3 mos. size for 6 mos. and 1 inch for 1 year.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

With No. 10 needles (3 mos.—No. 9 needles) cast on 42 sts. Work 2 ins. ribbing (K2. P2).

Proceed:

1st row: K28. Turn. 2nd row: K14. Turn. 3rd row: K15. Turn. 4th row: K16. Turn. 5th row: K17. Turn. 6th row: K18. Turn. Continue in this manner until all sts. are worked onto one needle. Continue even in Garter st. until work measures  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from beginning (3 mos.—5 ins.) at side edge.

Next row: K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. K2 tog. K1. Knit 3 rows even. Repeat last 4 rows twice. 36 sts. on needle. Continue even in Garter st. until work from beginning measures 6½ ins. (3 mos.—7 ins.) at side edge. Proceed:—

To make toe: K24. Turn. K12. Working on these 12 sts. knit 20 rows (10 ridges) for toe flap.

To make foot: Pick up and knit 9 sts. along side of flap. Knit remaining 12 sts. Next row: K33. Pick up and knit 9 sts. along other side of toe flap. Knit remaining 12 sts. 54 sts. on needle. Knit 4 ridges. Next row: K1. K2tog. K22. (K2tog.) twice. K22. K2tog. K1. Knit 4 ridges. Next row: K1. K2tog. K21. (K2tog) twice. K21. K2tog. K1. Next row: K11. K2tog. K20. (K2tog.) twice. K20. K2tog. K1. Next row: Knit. Next row: Knit. Cast off. Sew leg and foot seam. Make another bootee to correspond.

### BABY'S LEGGING SET for 1 to 6 months.

MATERIALS: 4 ply ANDALUSIAN.

1st size: 6 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 2nd size: 6 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. 3 buttons.

Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7½ sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension-see page 2.

TO MAKE AN OUTFIT TO FIT SIZES 8 MOS. TO 1 YEAR. Use 8 ozs. Medium 4 ply Fingering and two No. 9 Knitting Needles. Follow same instructions, but where measurements are given add ½ inch.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

THE COAT—RIGHT FRONT: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 38 sts. Work 7½ ins. in plain knitting (Garter st.) Proceed:—

1st row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: (buttonhole) K3. W1. twd. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. Repeat 2nd row once, then 1st and 2nd rows 6 times. 17th row: Knit. 18th row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. Repeat 17th row twice, then 3rd row once.

To shape armhole: Continue in plain knitting dec. 1 st. at armhole edge every following 3rd row to 23 sts. Knit 2 rows even.

To shape neck: K3. Wl. fwd. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: Cast off 10 sts. Knit to end of row. 4th row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. Repeat 4th row once, then 2nd row once. 7th row: K1. K2tog. K4. K2tog. K1. 8th row: Knit. Next 3 rows: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 12th and 14th rows: Knit. 13th row: K2tog. K1. K2tog. K1. K2tog. Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT: Cast on 38 sts. (2nd size—No. 9 needles). Work 7½ ins. plain knitting (Garter st.). Dec. 1 st. beginning of needle next and every alternate row to 30 sts. on needle.

To shape armhole: Continue in plain knitting dec. 1 st. at armhole edge every 3rd row to 22 sts. on needle. Knit 2 rows even. Proceed:—

1st row: Cast off 10 sts. Knit to last 3 sts. K2 tog. K1. 2nd row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd row: Knit. 4th row: K1. K2tog. K4. K2 tog. K1. Repeat 3rd row once, then 2nd row 3 times, then 3rd row once. 10th row: K2tog. K1. K2tog. 11th row: Knit. 12th row: K3tog. Fasten off.

BACK: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 64 sts. Work in plain knitting until work measures same as Front to underarm.

To shape armholes: Continue in plain knitting dec. 1 st. each end of needle next and every alternate row to 48 sts. on needle, then every 3rd row to 24 sts. on needle. Cast off.

SLEEVES: Cast on 30 sts. Work 18 rows plain knitting (Garter st.). Next row: K2. (Inc. 1 st. in next st. K4) 5 times. Inc. 1 st. in next st. K2. 36 sts. on needle. Continue in plain knitting inc. 1 st. each end of needle every following 8th row to 50 sts. on needle. Continue even in plain knitting until sleeve measures 6 ins. from beginning, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle next and every alternate

row to 22 sts. on needle, then every 3rd row to 6 sts. on needle. Cast off.

COLLAR: Cast on 10 sts. 1st row: Knit to last 3 sts. Inc. 1 st. in next st. K2. 2nd row: Knit. Repeat these 2 rows 4 times. 11th row: As 1st row. \*\*12th row: K14. Turn. 13th row: K14. Knit 6 rows even on the 16 sts.\*\*. Repeat from \*\* to \*\* 15 times, then 12th and 13th rows once. Proceed:—1st row: Knit. 2nd row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd row: Knit. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows to 10 sts. on needle. Cast off.

To make up: Press all pieces carefully. Sew seams. Sew sleeves in position, placing seam to seam. Sew collar in position, placing the ends 4 sts. from the edge of the fronts. Sew buttons to

correspond to buttonholes.

THE LEGGINGS, with feet: RIGHT LEG: With No. 10 needles (2nd size-No. 9 needles) cast on 68 sts. 1st row: K1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. K3. 2nd row: K1. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. P2. K1. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows twice. 7th row: (eyelets) K1. Wl. fwd. K2tog. \*P2. w.o.n. K2tog. Repeat from \* to last st. K1. Repeat 2nd row once, then 1st and 2nd rows twice. 13th row: K12. Turn. 14th and alternate rows: Knit. 15th row: K20. 17th row: K28. Turn. 19th row: K36. **21st row:** K44. Turn. **23rd row:** K52. Turn. **25th row:** K60. Turn. **26th row:** Knit. Work 76 rows plain knitting, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle next and every following 4th row to 50 sts. on needle, then every following 6th row to 40 sts. on needle. Knit 3 rows even. Next row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat last row 6 times.

To shape foot: 1st row: K18. Turn. 2nd row: K14. Turn. Repeat 2nd row 23 times. 26th row: K1. K2tog. K8. K2tog. K1. 27th row: K12. K2tog. K8. K2tog. K1. 27th row: K12. Sth row: K10. 30th row: K1. K2tog. K6. K2tog. K1. 29th row: K10. 30th row: K1. K2tog. K4. K2tog. K1. 31st row: K8. Break wool. Join wool at inside edge where the 22 sts. were left. K22. Next row: K22. Pick up and knit 16 sts. along side of foot. Knit the 8 sts. across toe. Pick up and knit 16 sts. along other side of foot and knit the 4 sts. which were left. (66 sts. on needle). Knit 11 rows even. Proceed:—1st row: K9. (K2tog) twice. K27. (K2tog) twice. K22. 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: K8. (K2tog) twice. K26. (K2tog) twice. K20. 4th row: Knit. Cast off.

LEFT LEG: Cast on 68 sts. (2nd size—No. 9 needles). Work first 12 rows as given for Right Leg. 13th and alternate rows: Knit. 14th row: K12. Turn. 16th row: K20. Turn. 18th row: K28. Turn. 20th row: K36. Turn. 22nd row: K44. Turn. 24th row: K52. Turn. 26th row: K60. Turn. 27th row: Knit. Knit 75 rows even, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle next and every following 4th row to 50 sts. on needle, then every following 6th row to 40 sts. on needle. Knit 3 rows even. Next row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row 6 times.

To shape foot: 1st row: K36. Turn. 2nd row: K14. Turn. Repeat 2nd row 23 times. 26th row: K1. K2tog. K8. K2tog. K1. 27th row: K12. 28th row: K1. K2tog. K6. K2tog. K1. 29th row: K10. 30th row: K1. K2tog. K4. K2tog. K1. 31st row: K8. Break wool. Join wool at inside edge where the 4 sts. were left. K4. Next row: K4. Pick up and knit 16 sts. along side of foot. Knit the 8 sts. across toe. Pick up and knit 16 sts. along other side of foot. Knit 22 sts. which were left (66 sts. on needle). Knit 22 sts. which were left (66 sts. on needle). Knit 11 rows even. Proceed:—1st row: K22. (K2tog) twice. K27. (K2tog) twice. K9. 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: K20. (K2tog) twice. K26. (K2tog) twice. K8. 4th row: Knit. Cast off.

To make up: Press pieces carefully. Sew front, back, leg and foot seams. Using 3 strands of wool 80 inches long, make a twisted cord and thread through eyelet holes at waist, attaching a tassel to each end of cord. See page 2.

1st size: 7 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 2nd size: 8 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. Length of elastic.

Tension: 7½ sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7 sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension—see page 2.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

### PULLOVER WITH TURTLE NECK AND PATTERN YOKE.

FRONT: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 80 sts. 1st row: K1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. K3. 2nd row: K1. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. P2. K1. Repeat these 2 rows 6 times. Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 9 ins. from beginning. (2nd size—10½ ins.) ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 4 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle on next and every alternate row to 64 sts. ending with purl row. Proceed:—

1st row: K1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. K3. 2nd row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows until armhole from first shaping measures 3 ins. (2nd size—3½ ins.) ending with purl row.

To shape neck: K1. (K2. P2) 5 times. Turn. Working on these 21 sts. and keeping continuity of pattern, dec. 1 st. at neck edge every alternate row to 18 sts. Continue even until work measures 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) from first shaping.

To shape shoulder: Keeping continuity of pattern, at armhole edge cast off 6 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Slip next 22 sts. on spare needle. Join wool and work on remaining 21 sts. to correspond to other side.

BACK: Work exactly as given for Front to 64 sts. on needle ending with purl row. Proceed:—

1st row: K1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. K3. 2nd row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows until work from first armhole shaping measures 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) ending with purl row.

To shape shoulders: Keeping continuity of pattern cast off 6 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Leave remaining sts. on spare needle. Sew left shoulder seam.

COLLAR: With right side of work facing K28 sts. from spare needle at Back of neck. Pick up and knit 12 sts. along left side of neck. K22 sts. from spare needle at Front of neck. Pick up and knit 12 sts. along right side of neck. (74 sts. on needle). 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row 6 times. 8th row: \*K2. (K2 tog) 5 times. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts. K2. 9th row: Knit, inc. 1 st. in every st. across row. Repeat 1st row 12 times. Cast off loosely in ribbing to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

SLEEVES: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 36 sts. 1st row: K1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. K3. 2nd row: K1. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. P2. K1. Repeat these 2 rows 8 times. Next row: Knit, increasing across row to 44 sts. Continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 9th and every following 8th row to 56 sts. Continue even until work from beginning measures 9 ins. (2nd size—12 ins.) ending with purl row. \*Cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 1 st. beginning following 2 rows.\* Repeat from \* to \* to 20 sts. on needle. Cast off.

To make up: Press carefully. Sew all seams. Sew in sleeves.

### PULLOVER WITH BOAT NECK:

For Materials see Boy's Suit page 19.

FRONT: Work exactly as given for Turtle Neck Pullover with Pattern Yoke page 19 to 64 sts. on needle, ending with purl row. Proceed:—

1st row: K1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts. K3 2nd row: K1. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to last 3 sts P2. K1. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulders and neck: Keeping continuity of pattern cast off 5 sts. beginning next 6 rows, (for shoulders). Cast off 3 sts. beginning next 10 rows. Cast off, (for neck).

BACK: Work exactly as given for Front.

SLEEVES: Work exactly as given for Turtle Neck Pullover with Pattern Yoke, page 20.

To make up: Press pieces carefully. Sew all seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew the 15 sts. allowed for each shoulder. Fold the shaped part of the neck to form a hem and sew in position on wrong side.

### PULLOVER WITH ROUND NECK:

For Materials see Boy's Suit page 19.

This pullover is worked in Stocking st. and may be varied with stripes if you wish to use up your left-over wools of the same weight. You may also use any fancy pattern that has a multiple of 2, 4, 5 or 8 sts. (That is, 80 sts. divides evenly and the same instruction is possible). If you use a cable st. pattern use a size larger needle as the cable draws the garment in.

FRONT: Work exactly as given for Turtle Neck pullover with Pattern Yoke, page 19 to 64 sts. on needle ending with purl row. Continue even in Stocking st. until work from first armhole shaping measures 2½ ins. (2nd size—3 ins.) ending with purl row.

To shape neck: K25. Turn. Working on these 25 sts. continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. at neck edge every alternate row to 18 sts. Continue even until work measures 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 6 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Slip next 14 sts. on spare needle. Join wool and work on remaining sts. to correspond to other side.

BACK: Work exactly as given for Front until work from first armhole shaping measures 3½ ins. (2nd size—4 ins.) ending with purl row.

To shape neck: K21. Turn. Working on these 21 sts. continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. at neck edge every alternate row to 18 sts. Shape shoulder as given for Front. Slip next 22 sts. on spare needle. Join wool and work on remaining 21 sts. to correspond to other side. Sew left shoulder seam.

NECKBAND: With right side of work facing pick up and knit 6 sts. along right side of neck. K22 sts. from spare needle at Back of neck. Pick up and knit 22 sts. along left side of neck. K14 sts. from spare needle at Front of neck. Pick up and knit 16 sts. along other side of neck. (80 sts. on needle). Work ¾ inch ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

SLEEVES: Work exactly as given for Turtle Neck Pullover, page 20.

To make up: Press pieces carefully. Sew all seams. Sew in sleeves.

THE KNICKERS:—RIGHT LEG: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 74 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row 3 times. 5th row: (eyelets) K2. \*W1. fwd. K2tog. P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row 7 times.

To shape Back: 1st row: K8. Turn. 2nd and alternate rows: Purl to last st. K1. 3rd row: K16. Turn. 5th row: K24. Turn. 7th row: K32. Turn. 9th row: K40. Turn. 11th row: K48. Tu.n. 13th row: K56. Turn. 15th row: K64. Turn. 17th row: Knit to end of row. 18th row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat last 2 rows 5 times. Continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. at short side of work on next and every following 6th row, at same time inc. 1 st. at long side of work on 3rd and every following 4th row to 88 sts. on needle. Still increasing at long side of work on every 4th row, inc. 1 st. at short side of work on every alternate row to 97 sts. Continue even until short side from beginning measures 9 ins. (2nd size—01/2 ins.) ending with purl row. Dec. 1 st. each end of needle on next and every alternate row to 77 sts. on needle ending with purl row. Proceed:-

1 1st row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off in ribbing.

LEFT LEG: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 74 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row 3 times. 5th row: (eyelets) K2. \*Wl. fwd. K2tog. P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row 7 times.

To shape Back: 1st row: Knit. 2nd row: K1. P7. Turn. 3rd and alternate rows: Knit. 4th row: K1. P15. Turn. 6th row: K1. P23. Turn. 8th row: K1. P31. Turn. 10th row: K1. P39. Turn. 12th row: K1. P47. Turn. 14th row: K1. P55. Turn. 16th row: K1. P63. Turn. 18th row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. 19th row: Knit to end of row. Repeat 18th and 19th rows 4 times then 18th row once. Continue in Stocking st. as given for Right Leg.

To make up: Press pieces carefully. Sew all seams. Thread elastic through eyelets at waist of knickers.

BOY'S PULLOVER with Round or "V" Neck and Sleeves, with "V" Neck and without Sleeves. For 6 yrs. (1st size) and 8 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 7 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 2nd size: 8 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. 2 ozs. less without sleeves (both sizes).

Tension:  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7 sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension—see page 2.

The Pullover is worked entirely in Stocking st. and may be varied with stripes if you wish to use your left-over wools of same weight. You may also use any fancy pattern that has a multiple of 2, 4, 6 or 8 sts. (That is, 96 sts. divides evenly and the same instruction is possible). If Cable pattern is used use size larger needle in each size, as the cable draws the garment in.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

### PULLOVER WITH SLEEVES and Round or "V" Neck.

FRONT: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 96 sts. Work 2 ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 11 ins. (2nd size—11½ ins.) from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 5 sts. beginning next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. each end of needle every alternate row to 76 sts. Proceed:—

To shape Round Neck: Continue even in Stocking. st. until work measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. (2nd size—3 ins.) from first armhole shaping ending with purl row. Next row: K27. Cast off 22 sts. Knit to end of row. Working on one shoulder continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. at neck edge every alternate row to 21 sts. Continue even until work measures 5 ins. (2nd size—5\frac{1}{2}\infty ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 7 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Join wool and work

other shoulder to correspond.

To shape "V" Neck: Work 2 rows even after armhole shaping, ending with purl row. Next row: K37. Cast off 2 sts. Knit to end of row. Working on 37 sts. for shoulder continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. at neck edge every 3rd row to 21 sts. Continue even in Stocking st. until armhole from first shaping measures 5 ins. (2nd size—5½ ins.)

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 7 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

BACK: Omitting neck shapings, work exactly as given for Front until work from first armhole shaping measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ins. (2nd size—6 ins.)

To shape shoulders for Round Neck: Cast off

7 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Cast off.

NECKBAND FOR ROUND NECK: Sew Right Shoulder seam. With right side of work facing pick up and knit 112 sts. around neck. Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

To shape shoulders for "V" Neck: Work as for

Round Neck.

NECKBAND FOR "V" NECK: Sew Right Shoulder seam. With right side of work facing pick up and knit 132 sts. around neck. 1st row: K2. (P1. K1) to centre 5 sts. at Front of neck. P2tog. Pl. P2tog. (K1. P1) to end of row. 2nd row: K2

(P1. K1) to centre 5 sts. at Front of neck. P2tog. K1. P2tog. (K1. P1) to end of row. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows for 1 inch. Cast off loosely in ribbing to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

SLEEVES: Cast on 48 sts. Work 4 ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 7th and every following 6 throw to 74 sts. on needle. Continue even until sleeve measures 15 ins. (2nd size—16 ins.) from beginning. (This allows for 2 inch turned-up cuff.) Cast off 2 sts. beginning every row to 28 sts. Cast off.

### SLEEVELESS PULLOVER WITH "V" NECK.

MATERIALS: See Boy's Pullover, page 23.

FRONT: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 96 sts. and work exactly as given for Front of Pullover with sleeves, page 24 until work measures 10 ins. (2nd size—10½ ins.) from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 5 sts. beginning next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. each end of needle every alternate row to 76 sts. Work ½ inch (2nd size—1 inch) even in Stocking st. ending with purl row.

To shape "V" Neck: K37. Cast off 2 sts. Knit to end of row. Continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. at neck edge every 3rd row to 21 sts. Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 6 ins. (2nd size—6½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 7 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

BACK: Work exactly as given for Front omitting neck shaping until work measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$  ins. (2nd size -7 ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 7 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Cast off.

NECKBAND: Work exactly as given for "V" neck of Pullover with sleeves, see page 24.

ARMBANDS: Sew Left Shoulder seam. With right side of work facing pick up and knit 122 sts. along armhole. Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing.

To make up: Press pieces carefully. Sew all seams. Sew sleeves in Pullover with sleeves.

GIRL'S PULLOVER with Round Neck, Short and Long Sleeves, for 2 yrs. (1st size) and 4 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 4 ozs. Two No. 10 Knitting Needles. 2nd size: 4 ozs. Two No. 9 Knitting Needles. 1 oz. extra for Long Sleeves (both sizes). One Button.

Tension:  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7 sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension-see page 2.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

FRONT: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 80 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1 Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row for 2 ins. Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 7½ ins. (2nd size—8 ins.) from beginning, ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 4 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle, next and every alternate row to 64 sts. on needle, ending with purl row. Proceed:—

1st and 2nd rows: \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 4 sts. K2. P1. K1. 3rd and 4th rows: K1. P1. K2. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat these 4 rows until work measures 3 ins. (2nd size—3½ ins.) from first armhole shaping ending with purl row.

To shape neck: Work 22 sts. in pattern. Turn. Working on these 22 sts. and keeping continuity of pattern dec. I st. at neck edge every alternate row to 18 sts. Continue even in pattern until work measures 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: Keeping continuity of pattern, at armhole edge cast off 6 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Slip next 20 sts. on spare needle. Join wool and work on remaining 22 sts. to correspond to other side.

BACK: Omitting neck shaping work exactly as given for Front until work measures 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulders: Keeping continuity of pattern cast off 6 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Leave remaining sts. on spare needle. Sew right shoulder seam.

NECKBAND: With right side of work facing, pick up and knit 12 sts. along left side of neck. K20 sts. from spare needle at front of neck. Pick up and knit 12 sts. along right side of neck. K28 sts. from spare needle at back of neck. (72 sts. on needle). 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. 2nd row: (buttonhole). K2. Wl. fwd. K2tog. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row 6 times. Cast off loosely in ribbing.

SHORT SLEEVES: Cast on 48 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row for 1 inch, increasing in last row to 56 sts. Continue even in Stocking st. until sleeve measures 3 ins. from beginning ending with purl row. \*Cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 1 st. beginning following 2 rows.\* Repeat from \* to \* 20 sts. on needle. Cast off.

LONG SLEEVES: Cast on 36 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat 1st row for 2 ins. Next row: Knit, increasing across row to 44 sts. Continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 9th and every following 8th row to 56 sts. Continue even until sleeve measures 9 ins. (2nd size—12 ins.) from beginning ending with purl row. Shape cap as given for Short Sleeves.

To make up: Press carefully. Sew all seams, leaving the left shoulder open for 1 inch. Sew in sleeves. Sew button to correspond to buttonhole on neckband.

GIRL'S PULLOVER with Short and Long Sleeves. For 6 yrs. (1st size) and 8 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 5 ozs. (1 oz. extra for long sleeves). Two No. 11 and two No. 10 Knitting Needles.

2nd size: 5 ozs. (2 ozs. extra for long sleeves). Two No. 10 and two No. 9 Knitting Needles. One Stitch Holder or spare needle. 2 Buttons.

Tension:  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7 sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension-see page 2.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

FRONT: With No. 11 needles (2nd size—No. 10 needles) cast on 70 sts. Work 2½ ins. ribbing (K1. P1). inc. in last row to 85 sts. Change to No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles). Proceed:—

1st row: Knit. 2nd row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 9½ ins. (2nd size—10 ins.) from beginning ending with 2nd row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 4 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle every alternate row to 71 sts. With right side of work facing proceed:—

Next row: (beginning Moss st. Yoke). K1. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Next row: (K1. P1) 19 times. K1. Turn. Leave remaining sts. on st. holder or spare needle. Working on the 39 sts. continue even in Moss st. for 1 inch ending at Front edge. Next row: (Ist buttonhole). (K1. P1) twice. Cast off 2 sts. Work in Moss st. to end of row. Next row: Work in Moss st. to cast-off sts. Cast on 2 sts. Work 4 Moss sts. Continue even in Moss st. working a 2nd buttonhole 1½ ins. above 1st buttonhole. Work 2 rows even in Moss st.

To shape neck: At neck edge cast off 11 sts. once, then dec. 1 st. every row to 21 sts. Continue even until work measures 5 ins. (2nd size—5½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 7 sts. every alternate row 3 times.

Cast on 7 sts. Working across 32 sts. from st. holder Moss st. to end of row. (39 sts. on needle). Omitting buttonholes continue even in Moss st. until same length as other side to neck shaping. Shape neck and shoulder to correspond.

BACK: Work as given for Front to 71 sts. on needle. Continue even in Moss st. until work measures 5 ins. (2nd size—5½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 7 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Cast off remaining sts.

LONG SLEEVES: With No. 11 needles (2nd size —No. 10 needles) cast on 42 sts. Work 2½ ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Change to No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) and continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 7th and every following 6th row to 68 sts. on needle. Continue even until sleeve measures 13 ins. (2nd size—14 ins.) from beginning. Cast off 2 sts. beginning every row to 20 sts. Cast off.

SHORT SLEEVES: With No. 11 needles (2nd size—No. 10 needles) cast on 58 sts. Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1) inc. in last row to 67 sts. on needle. Change to No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) and work  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. Moss st. Cast off 2 sts. beginning every row to 21 sts. Cast off.

COLLAR: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 71 sts. Work 2½ ins. Moss st. Cast off.

To make up: Press pieces carefully. Sew all seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew the 7 cast-on sts. in position on wrong side. Sew collar to pullover, placing ends 3 sts. from each Front edge. Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

GIRL'S PULLOVER with Short and Long Sleeves. For 10 yrs. (1st size) and 12 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 6 ozs. Two. No. 11 and two No. 10 Knitting Needles.

2nd size: 7 ozs. Two No. 10 and two No. 9 Knitting Needles.

1 oz. extra for Long Sleeves (both sizes). One Stitch Holder.

Tension:  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles. 7 sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

Check your tension-see page 2.

Note: If you wish to make this pullover in Stocking st. for sizes 12 and 14 yrs. This pullover is worked in ribbing throughout. Use small size needles for size 12 and the larger size for size 14 years. Use same number of stitches, but after  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. for ribbed band work entirely in Stocking st. following 2nd size instructions for both sizes, making the armholes  $6\frac{1}{2}$  ins. deep for both sizes.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

FRONT: With No. 11 needles (2nd size—No. 10 needles) cast on 106 sts. 1st row: \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts. K2. 2nd row: K1. P1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 4 sts. K2. P1. K1. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows for 2½ ins. Change to No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) and continue even in ribbing until work measures 10½ ins. (2nd size—11 ins.) from beginning ending with 2nd row.

To shape armholes: Keeping continuity of ribbing cast off 4 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle next and every alternate row 6 times. (86 sts. on needle). Continue even in ribbing until work measures  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from first armhole shaping.

To shape round neck: With right side of work facing rib 32 sts. Turn. Leave remaining sts. on st. holder, or spare needle. Keeping continuity of ribbing dec. 1 st. at neck edge every row to 24 sts. on needle. Continue even until work measures 6 ins. (2nd size—6½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 8 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Slip next 22 sts.

onto spare needle. Join wool to remaining 32 sts. and work to correspond to other shoulder.

BACK: Work exactly as given for Front to 86 sts. on needle. Continue even in ribbing until work measures 6 ins. (2nd size—6½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 8 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Leave remaining 38 sts. on needle.

NECKBAND: Sew Left Shoulder seam. With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) rib across 38 sts. at Back of neck. Pick up and knit 22 sts. along Left side of neck. Rib across 22 sts. at Front of neck. Pick up and knit 22 sts. along Right side of neck. (104 sts. on needle). Working backwards and forwards, work 1 inch ribbing (K2. P2). Cast off loosely in ribbing, to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

LONG SLEEVES: With No. 11 needles (2nd size—No. 10 needles) cast on 48 sts. 1st row: K2.

\*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts. P1. K1.
Repeat 1st row for 3 ins. inc. in last row to 52 sts.
Change to No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 9 needles) and work 22 rows even in ribbing. Keeping continuity of pattern inc. 1 st. each end of needle next and every following 6th row to 84 sts. on needle. Continue even until sleeve measures 15 ins. (2nd size—16 ins.) from beginning. Cast off 2 sts. beginning every row to 24 sts. Cast off.

SHORT SLEEVES: With No. 11 needles (2nd size—No. 10 needles) cast on 72 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts. P1. K1. Repeat 1st row for 1 inch. Keeping continuity of ribbing inc. 1 st. each end of needle next and every alternate row to 84 sts. on needle. Continue even in ribbing until sleeve measures 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) from beginning. Cast off 2 sts. beginning every row to 24 sts. Cast off.

To make up: Press carefully. Sew sleeve and side seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew right shoulder seam and neckband.

BOY'S HEAVY PULLOVER for 10, 12 and 14 years. With Turtle, Round, "V" or Boat Neck, with and without sleeves.

MATERIALS: SPECIAL SERVICE YARN.

1st size: 12 ozs. (4 ozs. less for sleeveless).

Two No. 10 and two No. 9 Knitting Needles.

One Stitch Holder.

2nd size: 14 ozs. (5 ozs. less for sleeveless). Two No. 10 and two No. 8 Knitting Needles. 3rd size: 14 ozs. (5 ozs. less for sleeveless).

Two No. 9 and two No. 7 Knitting Needles.

Two No. 5 at two No. 7 Knitting Needles.

Tension: 5½ sts. = 1 inch with No. 9 needles.

5 sts. = 1 inch with No. 8 needles.

4½ sts. = 1 inch with No. 7 needles.

Check your tension—see page 2.

The Pullover is worked entirely in Stocking st. and may be varied with stripes if you wish to use up your left-over wool of same weight. You may also use any fancy pattern that has a multiple of 2, 4, 6 or 8 sts. (That is, 72 sts. divides evenly and the same instruction is possible). If cable pattern is used, use size larger needle in each size as the cable draws the garment in.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets

thus: ( ).

PULLOVER WITH SLEEVES, WITH TURTLE, ROUND, "V" OR BOAT NECK.

FRONT: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 10 needles) (3rd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 72 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row for 3 ins. Change to larger size needle (see Materials, above), and continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 12 ins. (2nd size—12½ ins.) (3rd size—13 ins.) from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 3 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle every

alternate row to 60 sts. on needle.

The Turtle Neck: Continue even until work measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ins. (2nd size—6 ins.) (3rd size— $6\frac{1}{2}$  ins.) from first armhole shaping, ending with purl row. Proceed:

1st row: K20. Slip next 20 sts. onto st. holder or spare needle and leave for neck. K20. Working on one shoulder dec. 1 st. at neck edge every row to 15 sts. (3rd size—18 sts.). Continue even until work measures 6½ ins. (2nd size—7 ins.) (3rd size—7½ ins.) from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 5 sts. (2nd size—as 1st size) (3rd size—6 sts.) every alternate row 3 times. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Round Neck: With 60 sts. on needle continue even until work measures 3½ ins. (2nd and 3rd sizes—4 ins.) from first armhole shaping. K24. Cast off 12 sts. loosely. K24. Working on one shoulder dec. 1 st. at neck edge every row to 15 sts. (3rd size—18 sts.). Continue even until work measures 6½ ins. (2nd size—7 ins.) (3rd size—7½ ins.) from first armhole shaping. Shape shoulder as given for Turtle Neck, see above. Join wool to remaining sts. and work other shoulder to correspond.

The "V" Neck: With 60 sts. on needle, right side of work facing, K30. Turn. Leave remaining sts. on spare needle. Working on one shoulder proceed:—1st row: K4. Purl to last st. K1. 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: As 1st row. 4th row: K24. K2tog. K4. Keeping Garter st. border of 4 sts. at neck edge continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. inside border at neck edge every following 4th row to 19 sts. (2nd size as 1st size) (3rd size—every following 6th row to 22 sts.). Continue even until work measures 6½ ins. (2nd size—7 ins.) (3rd size—7½ ins.) from first armhole shaping. Shape shoulder as given for Turtle Neck, see above. Work 2 ins. Garter st. on remaining 4 sts. Cast off. Join wool to remaining sts. and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Boat Neck: With 60 sts. on needle, continue even in Stocking, st. until work measures 5 ins. (2nd size—5½ ins.) (3rd size—6 ins.) from first armhole shaping, ending with purl row. Work 1½ ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off in ribbing.

BACK: For the Boat Neck Pullover work the Back exactly as given for Front. For the other Pullovers proceed:—Casting on 72 sts. omitting all neck shaping, work as for Front until work measures same length to shoulders.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 5 sts. (2nd size as 1st size) (3rd size—6 sts.) beginning next 6 rows.

Cast off.

COLLAR FOR TURTLE NECK: Sew left shoulder seam. With right side of work facing and smaller size needle, pick up and knit 90 sts. (2nd size—94 sts.) (3rd size—98 sts.) around neck. Working backwards and forwards, work 4 ins. (2nd size—4½ ins.) (3rd size—5 ins.) ribbing (K1. P1.) Cast off loosely in ribbing, to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

NECKBAND FOR ROUND NECK: Sew left shoulder seam. With right side of work facing and smaller size needle, pick up and knit 26 sts. across back of neck, 20 sts. along left side of neck, 12 sts. across front and 20 sts. along right side of neck. (78 sts. on needle). Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing, to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

SLEEVES: With No. 10 needles (2nd size—No. 10 needles) (3rd size—No. 9 needles) cast on 36 sts. (2nd size—40 sts.) (3rd size—44 sts.). Work 3 ins. ribbing (K1. P1) increasing 4 sts. in last row. Change to larger size needles and continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 7th and every following 6th row to 58 sts. (all sizes). Continue even in Stocking st. until sleeve measures 15 ins. (2nd size—16 ins.) (3rd size—17 ins.) \*\*Cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 1 st. beginning following 2 rows. \*\* Repeat from \*\* to \*\* to 22 sts. on needle. Cast off.

### HEAVY SLEEVELESS PULLOVER WITH TURTLE, ROUND, "V" OR BOAT NECK.

For Sizes, Materials and Tension see Heavy Pullover with Sleeves, page 32.

FRONT: Work as given for Heavy Pullover with Sleeves, page 32, until work measures 11 ins. (2nd size—11½ ins.) (3rd size—12 ins.) from beginning ending with purl row. Next row: Knit. Next row: K12. Purl to last 12 sts. K12. Repeat these 2 rows once.

To shape armholes: Cast off 8 sts. Knit to end of row. 2nd row: Cast off 8 sts. K4. Purl to last 4 sts. K4. Keeping 4 sts. each end in Garter st. for borders, dec. 1 st. each end of needle, inside borders, every alternate row to 60 sts. on needle. Proceed:—

The Sleeveless Turtle Neck: Keeping 4 sts. each end of needle for armhole borders, and starting neck shaping ½ inch higher, continue as given for Turtle Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 32, until work measures 7 ins. (2nd size—7½ ins.) (3rd size—8 ins.) from first armhole shaping. Shape shoulder as given for Front of Turtle Neck Pullover with sleeves. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Sleeveless Round Neck: With 60 sts. on needle, keeping 4 sts. in Garter st. each end of needle for armhole borders, and starting neck shaping ½

inch higher, work as given for Round Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 33. When work measures 7 ins. (2nd size—7½ ins.) (3rd size—8 ins.) from first armhole shaping, shape shoulder as given for Front of Round Neck Pullover with sleeves. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Sleeveless "V" Neck: With 60 sts. on needle, keeping 4 sts. in Garter st. each end of needle for armhole borders, and 4 sts. for neck borders, starting neck shaping ½ inch higher, work as given for "V" Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 33. When work measures 7 ins. (2nd size—7½ ins.) (3rd size—8 ins.) from first armhole shaping shape shoulder as given for Front of "V" Neck Pullover with sleeves. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Sleeveless Boat Neck: With 60 sts. on needle, keeping 4 sts. in Garter st. each end of needle for armhole borders, starting ribbing ½ inch higher, finish as given for Boat Neck Pullover with sleeves.

BACK: For the Boat Neck Pullover work the Back exactly as given for Front. For the other Pullovers proceed:—Casting on 72 sts. omitting all neck shapings, work as for Front until work measures same length to shoulder shaping.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 5 sts. (2nd size—5 sts.) (3rd size—6 sts.) beginning next 6 rows. Cast off.

COLLAR FOR TURTLE NECK: Work as given for Turtle Neck Pullover with sleeves page 33,

NECKBAND FOR ROUND NECK: Work as given for Round Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 34.

To make up: Press carefully. Sew all seams, Sew ends of Garter st. borders across back of "V" neck. Sew sleeves in garments having sleeves.

#### GIRL'S PULLOVER for 16 yrs.

MATERIALS: 10 ozs. MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGERING.

Two No. 11 and two No. 9 Knitting Needles. One Stitch Holder.
Tension: 7 sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension-see page 2.

FRONT: With No. 11 needles cast on 104 sts. Work  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. ribbing (K1. P1) inc. 1 st. at end of last row. Change to No. 9 needles and continue even in Stocking st. until work measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from beginning ending with purl row.

To make pocket tops: 1st row: K5. (K1. P1) 13 times. K43. (P1. K1) 13 times. K5. 2nd row: K1. P4. (P1. K1) 13 times. P43. (K1. P1) 13 times. P4. K1. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows once, then 1st row once. 6th row: K1. P4. Cast off 27 sts. in ribbing. P41. Cast off 27 sts. in ribbing. P41. Leave these sts. on spare needle until pockets have been worked.

To make pockets: With No. 9 needles cast on 27 sts. Work 4 ins. Stocking st. ending with purl row. Leave on st. holder. Make another pocket to cor-

respond.

Beginning again on sts. of Front knit across row, knitting across the pocket sts. in place of cast-off sts. Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 9 ins. from beginning ending with purl row. Inc. 1 st. each end of needle on next and every following 12th row to 113 sts. on needle. Continue even until work measures 14½ ins. from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 3 sts. beginning next 6 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle every alternate row to 83 sts. on needle ending with purl row. Continue even until armhole from first shaping

measures 4½ ins. ending with purl row.

To shape neck: K31. Turn. Leave remaining sts. on st. holder. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge every row to 21 sts. on needle. Continue even until armhole from first shaping measures 7 ins.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 7 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Leaving next 21 sts. on st. holder work remaining sts. to correspond to

other shoulder.

BACK: Omitting pockets, work exactly as given for Front to 83 sts. on needle, ending with purl row. Continue even until armhole from first shaping measures 7 ins. ending with purl row.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 7 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Do not break wool.

NECKBAND: Sew left shoulder seam. With No. 11 needles and right side of work facing knit across sts. at back of neck. Pick up and knit 30 sts. along left side of neck. Knit across sts. at front of neck. Pick up and knit 30 sts. along right side of neck. Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing.

SLEEVES: With No. 11 needles cast on 48 sts. Work  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ins. ribbing (K1. P1) increasing across last row to 56 sts. on needle. Change to No. 9 needles and continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 9th and every following 8th row to 78 sts. on needle. Continue even until sleeve measures 17 ins. from beginning, or desired length.

To shape cap: \*Cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 1 st. beginning following 2 rows.\* Repeat from \* to \* to 18 sts. on needle. Cast off.

To make up: Press all pieces carefully. Sew all seams. Sew ends of ribbing across back of neck. Sew the pockets in position on wrong side.

BOY'S HEAVY PULLOVER for 16 years. With Turtle, Round, "V" or Boat Neck, with and without sleeves.

MATERIALS: SPECIAL SERVICE YARN

16 ozs. (6 ozs. less for sleeveless). Two No. 10 and two No. 8 Knitting Needles. Tension: 5 sts. = 1 inch with No. 8 needles. Check your tension—see page 2.

The Pullover is worked entirely in Stocking st. and may be varied with stripes if you wish to use up your left-over wool of same weight. You may al o use any fancy pattern that has a multiple of 2, 4, 6 or 7 sts. (That is, 84 sts. divides evenly and the same instruction is possible). If cable pattern is used, use size larger needle in each size as the cable draws the garment in.

### PULLOVER WITH SLEEVES, WITH TURTLE, ROUND, "V" OR BOAT NECK.

FRONT: With No. 10 needles cast on 84 sts. 1st row: K2. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row for 3 ins. Change to No. 8 needles and continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 13½ ins. from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 4 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle every alternate row to 66 sts. on needle.

The Turtle Neck: Continue even until work measures 7 ins. from first armhole shaping, ending with purl row. Proceed:—1st row: K22. Slip next 22 sts. onto st. holder or spare needle and leave for neck. K22. Working on one shoulder dec. 1 st. at neck edge every row to 18 sts. Continue even until work measures 8 ins-.from first armhole shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 6 sts. every alternate row 3 times. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Round Neck: With 66 sts. on needle continue even until work measures 4½ ins. from first armhole shaping. K26. Cast off 14 sts. loosely. K26. Working on one shoulder dec. 1 st. at neck edge every row to 18 sts. Continue even until work measures 8 ins. from first armhole shaping. Shape shoulder as given for Turtle Neck, see above. Join wool to remaining sts. and work other shoulder to correspond.

The "V" Neck: With 66 sts. on needle, right side of work facing, K33. Turn. Leave remaining sts. on spare needle. Working on one shoulder proceed:—
1st row: K4. Purl to last st. K1. 2nd row: Knit.
3rd row: As 1st row. 4th row: K27. K2tog. K4. Keeping Garter st. border of 4 sts. at neck edge continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. inside border at neck edge every following 4th row to 22 sts. on needle. Continue even until work measures 8 ins. from first armhole shaping. Shape shoulder as given for Turtle Neck, see above. Work 2½ ins. Garter st. on remaining 4 sts. Cast off. Join wool to remaining sts. and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Boat Neck: With 66 sts. on needle, continue even in Stocking st. until work measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from first armhole shaping, ending with purl row. Work  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off in ribbing

BACK: For the Boat Neck Pullover work the Back exactly as given for Front. For the other Pullovers proceed:—Casting on 84 sts. omitting all neck shaping, work as for Front until work measures same length to shoulders.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 6 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Cast off.

COLLAR FOR TURTLE NECK: Sew left shoulder seam. With right side of work facing and

No. 10 needles pick up and knit 102 sts. around neck. Working backwards and forwards, work 5½ ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing, to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

NECKBAND FOR ROUND NECK: Sew left shoulder seam. With right side of work facing and No. 10 needle, pick up and knit 30 sts. across back of neck, 20 sts. along left side of neck, 14 sts. across front and 20 sts. along right side of neck. (84 sts. on needle). Work 1 inch ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off loosely in ribbing, to allow plenty of stretch for pulling over head.

SLEEVES: With No. 10 needles cast on 48 sts. Work 3 ins. ribbing (K1. P1) increasing 4 sts. across last row. Change to No. 8 needles and continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 7th and every following 6th row to 64 sts. on needle. Continue even in Stocking st. until sleeve measures 18 ins. \*\*Cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 1 st. beginning following 2 rows.\*\* Repeat from \*\* to \*\* to 22 sts. on needle. Cast off.

### HEAVY SLEEVELESS PULLOVER WITH TURTLE, ROUND, "V" OR BOAT NECK.

For Sizes, Materials, and Tension see Heavy Pullover with Sleeves, page 37.

FRONT: Work as given for Heavy Pullover with Sleeves, page 37, until work measures 12½ ins. from beginning ending with purl row. Next row: Knit. Next row: K12. Purl to last 12 sts. K12. Repeat these 2 rows once.

To shape armholes: Cast off 8 sts. Knit to end of row. 2nd row: Cast off 8 sts. K4. Purl to last 4 sts. K4. Keeping 4 sts. each end in Garter st. for borders, dec. 1 st. each end of needle, inside borders, every alternate row to 66 sts. on needle. Proceed:—

The Sleeveless Turtle Neck: Keeping 4 sts. each end of needle for armhole borders, and starting neck shaping ½ inch higher, continue as given for Turtle Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 38, until work measures 8½ ins. from first armhole shaping. Shape shoulder as given for Front of Turtle Neck Pullover with sleeves. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Sleeveless Round Neck: With 66 sts. on needle, keeping 4 sts. in Garter st. each end of needle for armhole borders, and starting neck shaping ½

inch higher, work as given for Round Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 38. When work measures  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from first armhole shaping, shape shoulder as given for Front of Round Neck Pullover with sleeves. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Sleeveless "V" Neck: With 66 sts. on needle, keeping 4 sts. in Garter st. each end of needle for armhole borders, and 4 sts. for neck borders, starting neck shaping ½ inch higher, work as given for "V" Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 38. When work measures 8½ ins. from first armhole shaping shape shoulder as given for Front of "V" Neck Pullover with sleeves. Join wool and work other shoulder to correspond.

The Sleeveless Boat Neck: With 66 sts. on needle, keeping 4 sts. in Garter st. each end of needle for armhole borders, starting ribbing ½ inch higher, finish as given for Boat Neck Pullover with sleeves,

page 38.

BACK: For the Boat Neck Pullover work the Back exactly as given for Front. For the other Pullovers proceed:—Casting on 84 sts. omitting all neck shapings, work as for Front until work measures same length to shoulder shaping.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 6 sts. beginning

next 6 rows. Cast off.

COLLAR FOR TURTLE NECK: Work as given for Turtle Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 38.

NECKBAND FOR ROUND NECK: Work as given for Round Neck Pullover with sleeves, page 38:

To make up: Press carefully. Sew all seams. Sew ends of Garter st. borders across back of "V" neck. Sew sleeves in garments having sleeves.

### KNITTED CAPS. 8 to 16 yrs.

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

Four No. 9 Needles-points at both ends.

Cast on 96 sts. on 3 needles. P2. K2. for  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ins., or until work is suitable length for age required. Then 1 row plain.

Proceed:—Purl 1st st. on each needle, K2tog; K. to within 2 sts. from end of needle. K. these 2 tog. Continue dec. in this way 6 times on every row until 12 sts. remain. Bind off and sew up securely.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

RIGHT GLOVE: Cast on 34 sts. (12.12.10). Work 2 ins. ribbing (K1. P1) inc. 1 st. at beginning of last round. Work 6 rounds plain knitting.

To make gusset for thumb: Work as given for 6 year size, see page 43, until there are 7 sts. between increasings, instead of 9. Next round: K2. Slip next 10 sts. on thread for thumb. Cast on 3 sts. Knit to end of round. Knit even until work measures 2 ins. (2nd size—2½ ins.) from top of ribbing.

To make fingers: 1st finger: K3. Slip all but last 7 sts. onto thread. Cast on 3 sts. Knit last 7 sts. Divide sts. on 3 needles. Knit  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. (2nd size  $-1\frac{1}{2}$  ins.) (K2tog.) to last st. K1. Break wool. Thread through remaining sts. Fasten off securely. Finish all fingers and thumb in same manner.

2nd finger: K5 sts. from thread. Cast on 2 sts. Knit last 4 sts. of round. Pick up and knit 2 sts. at base of 1st finger. Knit 1¾ ins. (2nd size—1¾ ins.) K2tog. to last st. K1.

3rd finger: K4 sts. from thread. Cast on 2 sts. Knit last 4 sts. of round. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of 2nd finger. Knit 1½ ins. (2nd size—1½ ins.). K2tog. to last st. K1.

4th finger: Knit up remaining sts. from thread. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of 3rd finger. Knit 1¼ ins. (2nd size—1¼ ins.). K2tog. to last st. K1.

Thumb: Knit up sts. left for thumb. Pick up and knit 2 sts. at base of thumb. Knit 1¼ ins. (2nd size—1¼ ins.). K2tog. to end of round.

LEFT HAND: Work as given for Right Hand increasing at end of 1st needle instead of beginning of needle for thumb gusset.

GLOVES for Girls and Boys. 6 yrs. (1st size), 8 yrs. (2nd size) and 10 yrs. (3rd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 1 oz. Set of 4 No. 12 Steel Knitting Needles.

2nd size: 2 ozs. Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles.

3rd size: 2 ozs. Set of 4 No. 10 Steel Knitting Needles.

(Points at both ends.)

Tension:  $8\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 12 needles. 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 11 needles.  $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 10 needles.

Check your tension—see page 2.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

\*\*\*Cast on 40 sts. (14.14.12). Work 3 ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Knit 2 rounds even.

To make gusset for thumb: K1. Inc. 1 st. in next st. K1. Inc. 1 st. in next st. Knit to end of round. Knit 2 rounds even.

Next round: K1. Inc. 1 st. in next st. K3. Inc. 1 st. in next st. Knit to end of round. Knit 2 rounds even. Continue inc. 2 sts. for thumb in this manner on next and every following 3rd round until there are 9 sts. between increasings.

Next round: K2. Slip next 12 sts. on thread for thumb. Cast on 3 sts. Knit to end of round.\*\*\*
Knit even until work measures 2½ ins. (2nd size—2¾ ins.) (3rd size—3 ins.) from top of ribbing.

To make fingers: 1st finger: K6. Slip all but last 6 sts. in round onto thread. Cast on 2 sts. Knit last 6 sts. Divide sts. on 3 needles. Knit 1¾ ins. (2nd size—2 ins.) (3rd size—2¼ ins.). K2tog. to end of round. Break wool. Thread end through remaining sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

Finish all fingers and thumb in same manner.

4th finger: Knit up remaining sts. from thread. Pick up and knit 2 sts. at base of 3rd finger. Knit 1½ ins. (2nd size—1¾ ins.) (3rd size—2 ins.). K2tog. to end of round.

Thumb: Knit up sts. left for thumb. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of thumb. Knit 1½ ins. (2nd size—1½ ins.) (3rd size—1¾ ins.). K2tog. to last st. of round. K1.

LEFT HAND: Work as given for Right Hand increasing at end of 1st needle instead of beginning of needle for thumb gusset.

GLOVES for Girls and Boys. 12 yrs. (1st size) and 14 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 2 ozs. Set of 4 No. 12 Steel Knitting Needles.

2nd size: 2 ozs. Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles.

(Points at both ends.)

Tension:  $8\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch with No. 12 needles. 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 11 needles.

Check your tension-see page 2.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

Cast on 48 sts. (16.16.16). Work 3 ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Knit 2 rounds even.

To make gusset for thumb: Work as given for 6 years size, see page 43, until there are 13 sts. between increasings, instead of 9.

Next round: K2. Slip next 16 sts. on thread for thumb. Cast on 3 sts. Knit to end of round. Knit even until work measures  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ins. (2nd size—3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ins.) from top of ribbing.

To make fingers: 1st finger: K7. Slip all but last 7 sts. onto thread. Cast on 2 sts. Knit last 7 sts. Divide sts. on 3 needles. Knit 2½ ins. (2nd size—2¾ ins.). K2tog. to end of round. Break wool. Thread through remaining sts. Fasten off securely. Finish all fingers and thumb in same manner.

2nd finger: Knit 6 sts. from thread. Cast on 2 sts. Knit last 6 sts. of round. Pick up and knit 2 sts. at base of 1st finger. Knit 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ins. (2nd size—3 ins.). K2tog. to end of round.

3rd finger: Knit 5 sts. from thread. Cast on 3 sts. Knit last 6 sts. of round. Pick up and knit 2 sts. at base of 2nd finger. Knit 2½ ins. (2nd size—2¾ ins.). K2tog. to end of round.

4th finger: Knit up remaining sts. from thread. Pick up and knit 2 sts. at base of 3rd finger. Knit 2½ ins. (2nd size—2½ ins.). K2tog. to end of round.

Thumb: Knit up sts. left for thumb. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of thumb. Knit 2½ ins. (2nd size—2½ ins.). K2tog. to last st. of round K1.

LEFT HAND: Work as given for Right Hand, increasing at end of 1st needle instead of beginning of needle for thumb gusset.

#### GRAFTING

Break wool leaving an end 12 ins. long. Thread end through a wool needle. \*Inserting the wool needle as if for knitting into 1st st. of front needle, draw it through the st. and slip the latter off the needle; inserting the needle, as if for purling into the 2nd st. of front needle, draw the wool through and let the st. remain on the needle; taking the wool under front needle and inserting the wool needle as if for purling, into 1st st. of back needle, draw the wool through this st. and slip the latter off the needle; inserting the needle, as if for knitting, into 2nd st. of back needle, draw the wool through and let the st. remain on the needle; bring the wool forward under the needle and repeat from \* until all sts. are worked off, darning in the end of wool securely.

SOCKS for Boys and Girls with French heel and round toe. 2 yrs. (1st size) and 4 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: 1 oz. 4 PLY ANDALUSIAN. Set of 4 No. 13 Steel Knitting Needles.

(Points at both ends.) Tension:  $9\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension—see page 2.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

Cast on 48 sts. loosely. (16.16.16). Work 2 ins.

ribbing (K1. P1).

Next round: \*K3. P1. Repeat from \* to end of round. Repeat this round for 3 ins. (2nd size—3½ ins.).

To make heel: K12. Slip last 12 sts. of round onto other end of same needle. Divide remaining sts. on 2 needles and leave for instep. Work 19 rows Stocking st.

To shape heel: K13. Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Turn. P4. P2tog. P1. Turn. K5. Sl. 1. K1. p.s. s.o. K1. Turn. P6. P2tog. P1. Turn. Continue in this manner until all sts. are on one needle ending with purl row. Knit back 7 sts. Slip all instep sts. onto one needle. Proceed:—

1st needle: Knit across remaining 7 sts. at back of heel. Pick up and knit 10 sts. along side of heel. 2nd needle: Work across sts. left for instep in ribing. 3rd needle: Pick up and knit 10 sts. along other side of heel. Knit remaining 7 sts. at back of heel. Keeping 2nd needle in ribbing, work 1 round even. Next round: 1st needle: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle: Rib. 3rd needle: K1. Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. Knit to end of round. Work 1 round even. Repeat last 2 rounds until 12 sts. remain on each of 1st and 3rd needles. 48 sts. in round. Continue even still keeping 2nd needle in ribbing until foot measures 3½ ins. for size 5½ inch foot. (2nd size—4½ ins. for size 6½ inch foot) from where sts. were picked up at heel.

To shape toe: 1st round: \*K6. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. Knit 2 rounds even. 4th round: \*K5. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. Knit 2 rounds even. Continue decreasing in this manner every 3rd round to 18 sts. in round. Next round: \*K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. Break wool and thread end through remaining sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

### BOY'S STOCKINGS for 6 years.

MATERIALS: 3 ozs. MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGERING.

Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles. (Points at both ends.)
Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension-see page 2.

Cast on 56 sts. loosely. (18.18.20). Work 4 ins. ribbing (K1. P1). inc. 7 sts. in last round. 63 sts. in round.

Next round: Knit to last st. P1. (This is seam st.) Repeat this round for 4½ ins. Next round: K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. of round. K2tog. t.b.l.

P1. Keeping seam st. knit 5 rounds even. Repeat these 6 rounds to 49 sts. in round. Keeping seam st. continue even until work measures 14 ins. from caston sts.

To make heel: Knit first 12 sts. off first needle and slip last 13 sts. off 3rd needle onto one needle. These 25 sts. are for heel. Divide remaining 24 sts. on 2 needles and leave for instep. Working on the 25 heel sts. proceed:—Ist row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. 2nd row: \*K1. Sl. 1 being very careful not to tighten wool behind the slipped st. This prevents a ridge. Repeat from \* to last st. K1. Repeat these 2 rows for 2 ins. ending with 1st row.

To shape heel: K13. Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Turn. 2nd row: P3. P2tog. P1. Turn. 3rd row: K4. Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Turn. 4th row: P5. P2tog. P1. Turn. 5th row: K6. Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Turn. Continue in this manner, working 1 st. extra every row until all sts. are on one needle ending with purl row. 13 sts. on needle. Knit back 7 sts. This is 3rd needle. Put instep sts. onto one needle. (This is the 2nd needle). 1st needle: K6 remaining heel sts. Pick up and knit 14 sts. along side of heel, inserting the needle through the knot formed by the stitch knitted at beginning and end of each row. 2nd needle: K24. 3rd needle: Pick up and knit 14 sts. along other side of heel. K5. K2tog. There are 20 sts. on 1st needle, 24 sts. on 2nd needle and 20 sts. on 3rd needle.

To shape instep: 1st round: Knit across each needle. 2nd round: 1st needle: Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 2nd needle: Knit. 3rd needle: K2. K2tog. t.b.l. Knit to end of needle. Repeat these 2 rounds until there are 12 sts. on 1st needle, 24 sts. on 2nd needle and 12 sts. on 3rd needle. 48 sts. in round. Continue in plain knitting until work measures 4½ ins. from where sts. were picked up at heel for size 7½ inch foot.

To shape toe: 1st round: 1st needle: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle: K1. K2 tog. t.b.l. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd needle: K1. K2tog. t.b.l. Knit to end of needle. 2nd round: Knit across each needle. Repeat these 2 rounds until there are 24 sts. in round. Knit the sts. of 1st needle onto end of 3rd needle. Break wool leaving an end 12 ins. long. Thread end through a wool needle. Graft toe. For Grafting see page 45.

BOY'S STOCKINGS for 8 yrs. (1st size) and 10 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 4 ozs. Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles.

2nd size: 4 ozs. Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles.

(Points at both ends).

Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension-see page 2.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

Cast on 60 sts. loosely (20.20.20). (2nd size—cast on 64 sts. loosely (20.22.22). Work 4 ins. ribbing (K1. P1) inc. 7 sts. in last round. 67 sts. (2nd size—71 sts.) in round. Next round: Knit to last st. P1. (This is seam st.). Repeat this round for 5 ins. Next round: K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. of round. K2tog. t.b.l. P1. Keeping seam st. knit 5 rounds even. Repeat these 6 rounds to 53 sts. (2nd size—57 sts.) in round. Keeping seam st. continue even until work measures 15 ins. (2nd size—16 ins.) from cast-on sts.

To make heel: Knit first 13 sts. (2nd size—14 sts.) off first needle and slip last 14 sts. (2nd size—15 sts.) off 3rd needle onto one needle. These 27 sts. (2nd size—29 sts.) are for heel. Divide remaining 26 sts. (2nd size—28 sts.) on 2 needles and leave for instep. Working on the 27 heel sts. (2nd size—29 sts.) proceed:—

1st row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. 2nd row: \*K1. Sl. 1 being very careful not to tighten wool behind the slipped st. This prevents a ridge. Repeat from \* to last st. K1. Repeat these 2 rows for 2 ins. ending with 1st row.

To shape heel: K14. (2nd size—K15). Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Turn. 2nd row: P3. P2tog. P1. Turn. 3rd row: K4. Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Turn. 4th row: P5. P2tog. P1. Turn. 5th row: K6. Sl. 1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Turn. Continue in this manner, working 1 st. extra every row until all sts. are on one needle ending with purl row. 15 sts. on needle (both sizes). Knit back 8 sts. This is 3rd needle. Put instep sts. onto one needle. This is 2nd needle. Ist needle: Knit 7 remaining heel sts. Pick

up and knit 14 sts. along side of heel, inserting the needle through the knot formed by the stitch knitted at beginning and end of each row. 2nd needle: K26. (2nd size—K28). 3rd needle: Pick up and knit 14 sts. along other side of heel. K6. K2tog. There are 21 sts. on 1st needle, 26 sts. on 2nd needle and 21 sts. on 3rd needle. (2nd size—21 sts. on 1st needle, 28 sts. on 2nd needle).

To shape instep: 1st round: Knit across each needle. 2nd round: 1st needle: Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 2nd needle: Knit. 3rd needle: K2. K2tog. t.b.l. Knit to end of needle. Repeat these 2 rounds until there are 13 sts. on 1st needle, 26 sts. on 2nd needle and 13 sts. on 3rd needle. 52 sts. in round. (2nd size—Repeat these 2 rounds until there are 14 sts. on 1st needle, 28 sts. on 2nd needle and 14 sts. on 3rd needle. 50 sts. in round). Continue in plain knitting until work measures (from where sts. were picked up at heel):—5 ins. for size 8 inch foot. (2nd size—5½ ins. for size 8½ inch foot).

To shape toe: 1st round: Ist needle: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle: K1. K2tog. t.b.l. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd needle: K1. K2tog. t.b.l. Knit to end of needle. 2nd round: Knit across each needle. Repeat these 2 rounds until there are 28 sts. in round (both sizes). Knit the sts. of 1st needle onto end of 3rd needle. Break wool leaving an end 12 ins. long. Thread end through a wool needle. Graft toe. For Grafting see page 45.

MITTS for Girls and Boys. 2 yrs. (1st size) and 4 yrs. (2nd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 1 oz. Set of 4 No. 12 Steel Knitting Needles.

2nd size: 1 oz. Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles.

(Points at both ends).

Tension: 8½ sts. = 1 inch with No. 12 needles. 8 sts. = 1 inch with No. 11 needles.

Check your tension—see page 2.

Follow these instructions for both sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

Cast on 36 sts. (12.12.12). Work 2 ins. ribbing (K1. P1).

To make gusset for thumb: Work as given for Girl's Gloves, 6 year size, see page 43, until there are 7 sts. between increasings instead of 9. Next round: K2. Slip next 10 sts. on thread for thumb. Cast on 3 sts. Knit to end of round. Work even in rounds until work measures  $2\frac{3}{4}$  ins. (2nd size— $3\frac{1}{4}$  ins.) from top of ribbing.

To shape top: 1st round: \*K7. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. Knit 1 round even. 3rd round: \*K6. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. Continue decreasing in this manner every alternate round, that is, having 1 st. less between sts. knit together to 12 sts. in round. Next round: (K2tog). 6 times. Break wool. Thread end through remaining sts. Fasten off securely.

Thumb: Knit up sts. left for thumb. Pick up and knit 2 sts. at base of thumb. Knit 1½ ins. (2nd size -1½ ins.). K2tog. to end of round. Break wool and finish as for top. Make another mitt to correspond.

MITTS for Girls and Boys. 6 yrs. (1st size), 8 yrs. (2nd size), and 10 yrs. (3rd size).

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING.

1st size: 1 oz. Set of 4 No. 12 Steel Knitting Needles.

2nd size: 1 oz. Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles.

3rd size: 2 ozs. Set of 4 No. 10 Steel Knitting Needles.

(Points at both ends.)

Tension: 8½ sts. =1 inch with No. 12 needles. 8 sts. =1 inch with No. 11 needles. 7½ sts. =1 inch with No. 10 needles.

Check your tension—see page 2.

Follow these instructions for all sizes. Any necessary changes will be found in brackets thus: ( ).

Work from \*\*\* to \*\*\* as given for Gloves, size 6 years, see page 43. Knit even in rounds until work measures 33/4 ins. (2nd size—4 ins.) (3rd size—41/4 ins.) from top of ribbing.

To shape top: 1st round: K6. \*K5. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. Work 2 rounds even, also after each of the following rounds:

4th round: \*K4. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. 7th round: \*K3. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. 10th round: \*K2. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. 13th round: \*K1. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of round. 14th round: Break wool. Thread through remaining sts. and fasten securely. Work thumb as given for Gloves 6, 8 and 10 year size, page 43.

Make another mitt to correspond.

#### GIRL'S SCARF.

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING. 2 ozs.

Two No. 7 Knitting Needles.

Tension: 6 sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension—see page 2.

Cast on 40 sts. 1st row: Inc. 1 st. in 1st st. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd row: Knit. Repeat 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 38 ins. from beginning. Cast off.

### BOY'S SCARF.

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING. 4 ozs.

Two No. 8 Knitting Needles. Tension: 6½ sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension-see page 2.

Cast on 61 sts. Work 1 inch Moss st. inc. 1 st. in last row. Proceed:—\*\*1st row: Work 7 sts. Moss st. \*P4. K4. Repeat from \* to last 7 sts. Work 7 sts. Moss st. Repeat 1st row 3 times. 5th row: Work 7 sts. Moss st. \*K4. P4. Repeat from \* to last 7 sts. Work 7 sts. Moss st. Repeat 5th row 3 times.\*\* Repeat from \*\* to \*\* until work measures approx. 40 ins. from beginning ending with 4th pattern row, dec. 1 st. in last row. Work 1 inch Moss st. Cast off.

### WOMEN'S GARMENTS

#### WOMEN'S CARDIGAN.

MATERIALS: SPECIAL SERVICE YARN. 16 ozs.

Two No. 10 and two No. 9 Knitting Needles.

5 Buttons.

MEASUREMENTS: Bust 38 ins. Length from top of shoulder  $23\frac{1}{2}$  ins. Length of sleeve, underarm seam 20 ins.

Tension:  $5\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch.

### Check your tension-see page 2.

BACK: With No. 9 needles cast on 96 sts. Work 1½ ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 15½ ins. from beginning, ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 5 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle, every alternate row to 76 sts. on needle. Continue even until armhole measures 8 ins. from first shaping, ending with purl row.

To shape shoulders: Cast off 9 sts. beginning next 6 rows. Cast off remaining sts.

LEFT FRONT: With No. 9 needles cast on 48 sts. Work  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures  $15\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape armhole: Cast off 5 sts. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. (Front edge). Continue in Stocking st. dec. 1 st. at armhole edge every alternate row 5 times, at same time continue dec. 1 st. at Front edge every 6th row to 27 sts. on needle. Armhole now measures 8 ins. from first shaping.

To shape shoulder: At armhole edge cast off 9 sts. every alternate row 3 times.

RIGHT FRONT: Work as given for Left Front until work measures 15½ ins. from beginning ending with knit row.

To shape armhole: Cast off 5 sts. Purl to last 3 sts. P2tog. P1. Having all shapings for opposite side, continue to correspond to Left Front.

SLEEVES: With No. 10 needles cast on 46 sts. Work 4 ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Change to No. 9 needles and continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 9th, then every following 8th row

to 70 sts, on needle. Continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 20 ins. from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape cap: Dec. 1 st. each end of needle every alternate row to 46 sts. on needle, then dec. 1 st. each end of needle every row to 14 sts. on needle. Cast off remaining sts.

THE POCKETS: (Make 2). With No. 9 needles cast on 28 sts. Work 4 ins. even in Stocking st. Change to No. 10 needles and work 10 rows ribbing (K1. P1). Cast off in ribbing.

FRONT AND NECK BAND: (made in one piece). With No. 10 needles cast on 8 sts. Work ½ inch ribbing (K1. P1). Next row: (1st buttonhole). Rib 3. Cast off 3 sts. Rib 2. Next row: Rib 2. Cast on 3 sts. Rib 3. Continue in ribbing, working 4 more buttonholes in this manner, 3 ins. apart. Continue even in ribbing until work measures 55 ins. from beginning. Cast off.

To make up: Press all pieces carefully. Sew side shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew ribbed band around Fronts and Neck, arranging the band so that 2 st. edge of the buttonholes is sewn to the Right Front of the Cardigan. Sew Pockets on each Front, about ¾ inch above ribbed band and 1¼ ins. in from each Front. Sew buttons on Left Front band to correspond to buttonholes.

### WOMEN'S PULLOVER with Boat Neck.

MATERIALS: SPECIAL SERVICE YARN.

Two No. 11 and two No. 9 Knitting Needles. MEASUREMENTS: Bust 34–36 ins. Length from top of shoulder 18 ins. Length of sleeve, underarm seam 17 ins.

Tension:  $5\frac{1}{2}$  sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension-see page 2.

FRONT: With No. 11 needles cast on 92 sts. Work 3½ ins. ribbing (K2. P2). Change to No. 9 needles and continue even in Stocking st. until work measures 11 ins. from beginning ending with purl row.

To shape armholes: Cast off 5 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 2 sts. beginning following 4 rows. 74 sts. on needle. Work 2 ins. even in Stocking stending with purl row. Change to No. 11 needles and proceed:—

1st row: K2. \*P2. K2. Repeat from \* to end of row. 2nd row: K1. P1. \*K2. P2. Repeat from \* to last 4 sts. K2. P1. K1. Repeat these 2 rows until armhole measures 7 ins. from first shaping. Using No. 9 needle cast off in ribbing.

BACK: Work exactly as given for Front.

SLEEVES: With No. 11 needles cast on 52 sts. Work 2½ ins. ribbing (K2. P2). Change to No. 9 needles and continue in Stocking st. inc. 1 st. each end of needle on 7th then every following 6th row to 68 sts. on needle. Continue even until work measures 17 ins. from beginning, ending with purl row.

To shape cap: \* Cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows, then 1 st. beginning following 2 rows.\* Repeat from \* to \* to 38 sts. on needle, then cast off 1 st. beginning every row to 16 sts. on needle ending with purl row. Next row: (K2tog. K1. K2tog.) 3 times. K1. 10 sts. on needle. Cast off purlways.

To make up: Press all pieces being very careful not to flatten ribbed portions. Sew all seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew shoulder seams  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. in from each armhole.

#### GLOVES FOR WOMEN.

MATERIALS: MEDIUM 4 PLY FINGER-ING. 2 ozs.

Set of 4 No. 11 Steel Knitting Needles. (Points at both ends.)

Tension: 8 sts. = 1 inch.

Check your tension-see page. 2.

Cast on 52 sts. (16.16.20). Work 3 ins. ribbing (K1. P1). Knit 2 rounds even.

To make gusset for thumb: Work as given for 6 years size, see page 43 until there are 15 sts. between increasings, instead of 9.

Next round: K2. Slip next 18 sts. on thread for thumb. Cast on 3 sts. Knit to end of round. Knit even until work measures 3¾ ins. from top of ribbing.

To make fingers: 1st finger: K8. Slip all but last 8 sts. onto thread. Cast on 2 sts. Knit last 8 sts. Divide sts. on 3 needles. Knit 2¾ ins. K2tog. to end of round. Break wool. Thread through remaining sts. Fasten off securely.

Finish all fingers and thumb in same manner.

2nd finger: Knit 6 sts. from thread. Cast on 3 sts. Knit last 6 sts. of round. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of 1st finger. Knit 3 ins. K2tog. to end of round.

3rd finger: Knit 5 sts. from thread. Cast on 3 sts. Knit last 6 sts. of round. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of 2nd finger. Knit 2¾ ins. K2tog. to last st. of round. K1.

4th finger: Knit up remaining sts. from thread. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of 3rd finger. Knit 2½ ins. K2tog. to last st. of round. K1.

Thumb: Knit up sts. left for thumb. Pick up and knit 3 sts. at base of thumb. Knit 1 round dec. 2 sts. over the 3 sts. which were picked up. Knit 2½ ins. K2tog. to last st. of round. K1.

LEFT HAND: Work as given for Right Hand increasing at end of 1st needle instead of beginning of needle for thumb gusset.
