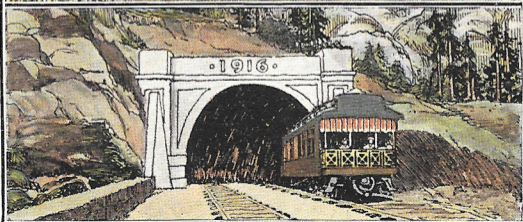
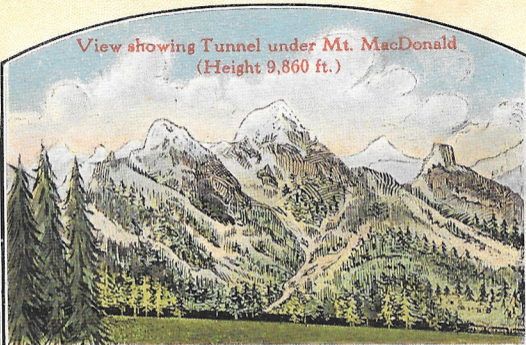
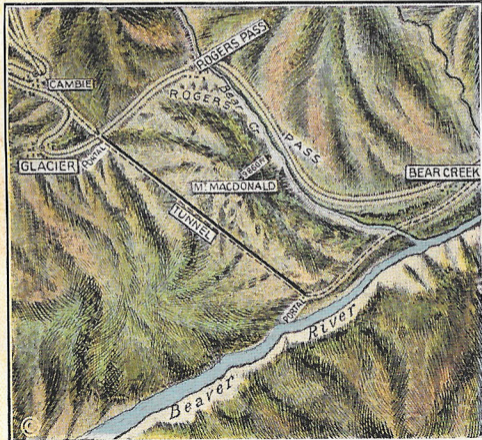


CONNAUGHT TUNNEL.—CANADIAN ROCKIES.

LONGEST TUNNEL IN NORTH AMERICA.

Length 5 miles with double track. Cost \$5,500,000.00. Completed in 23 Months and one year ahead of contract time, the fastest time ever recorded on this Continent. Shortens the rail time 4.3 miles and reduces the elevation of track through Rogers Pass by 552 ft., eliminates 5 miles of snowsheds, also curvature to the amount of seven complete circles.
