*Article 117.*—Table of rates, delete "Staff Sergeant" opposite "While on probation," leaving a blank space, and on following line opposite "On appointment" add "Staff Sergeant" in lieu of the ditto marks. **G.O. 58**

*Article 137.*—Table of rates, delete "Armament Staff Sergeant" opposite "While on probation," leaving a blank space, and on following line opposite "After probationary period" add "Armament Staff Sergeant" in lieu of the ditto marks.
