SOLDIERS' FAVORITE PASSAGE

Judging from the underscoring and stains found in the Bibles at certain service centers in camps and at the Battle Stations, Psalm 139:7-12 is a great favorite with the boys. Here is how it reads:

"Whither shall I go from thy spirit? Or whither shall I flee from thy presence?

If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou are there.

If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;

Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.

If I say, Surely darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me.

Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee."

A casual reading of the above verses will reveal why these words are so popular. They are good verses for all of us to commit to memory and then REMEMBER forever.
